BC Floods

Rail update

- All rail services coming in and out of the Port of Vancouver have been halted
- Both CN and CP are working to clear their tracks as safely as possible
- Additional rain and land/mudslides are adding to the situation and extending delays
- CN
 - All intermodal and carload traffic northbound and eastbound from Vancouver
 - Traffic inbound to Vancouver from east/north of Kamloops continue to be affected as well
- CP
 - All exports destined to the Port of Vancouver have been embargoed
 - No perishables, reefers to/from the Port of Vancouver are being accepted

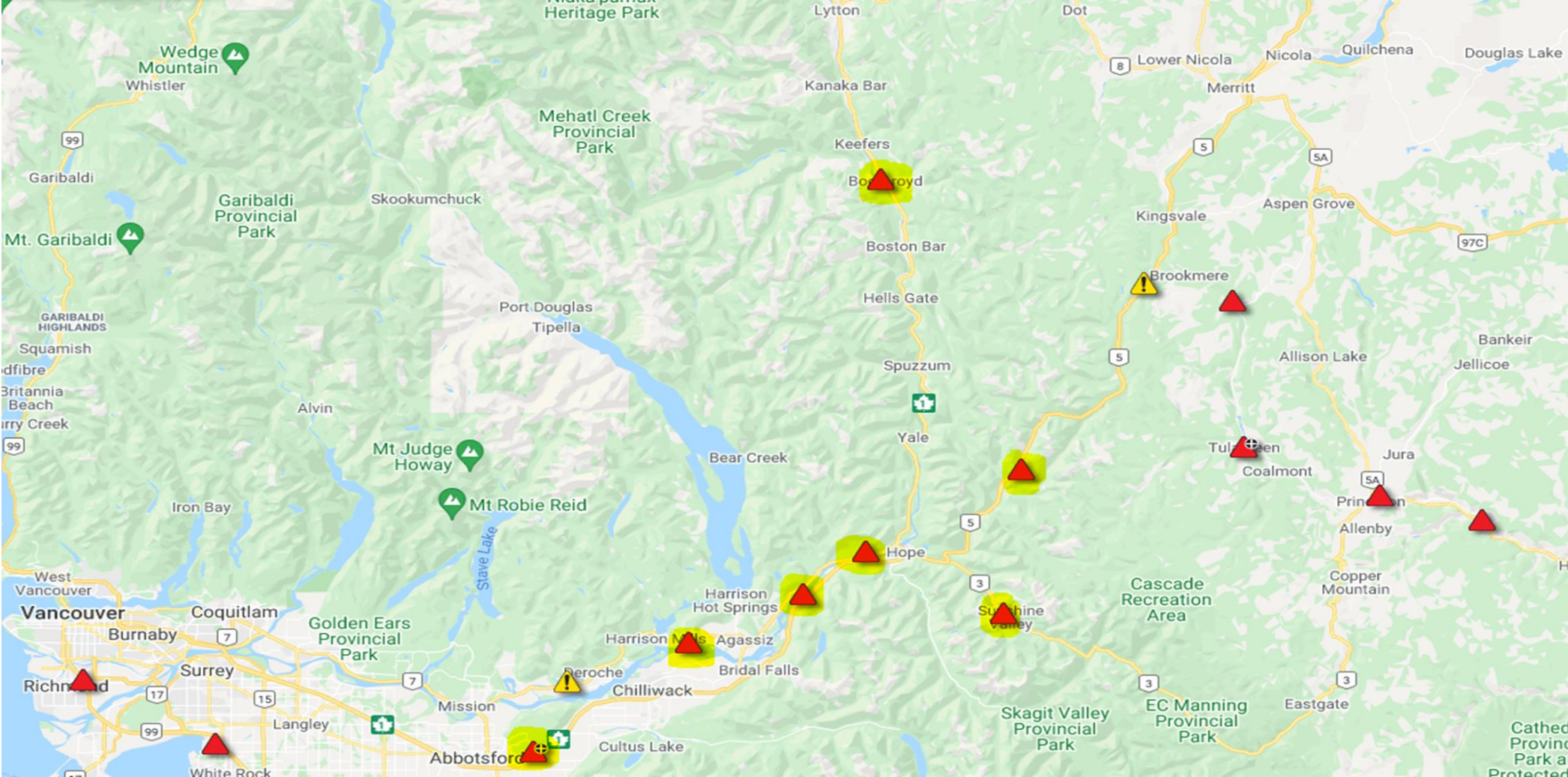

Road update

- Highway 1 – closed both directions
 - Flooding – Abbotsford to Chilliwack. Assessment in progress and no estimated time of re-opening
 - Flooding and Rock Slide – Hope to Spences Bridge. Assessment in progress and no estimated time of re-opening
 - Mudslide – Hope to 2 km East of Chilliwack. Assessment in progress and no estimated time of re-opening
- Highway 3 – closed both directions
 - Mudslide – Sunshine Valley to Allison Pass . Assessment in progress and no estimated time of re-opening
- Highway 5 – closed both directions
 - Washout – Merritt to Hope. Assessment in progress and no estimated time of re-opening. No detour.
- Highway 7 – closed both directions
 - Mudslide and Flooding – Highlands Blvd and Bodnar Rd (Kent). Assessment in progress and no estimated time of re-opening
 - Mudslide – Kent to 1 km East of Hope. Assessment in progress and no estimated time of re-opening
- Highway 11 – closed both directions
 - Flooding – Abbotsford. Assessment in progress and no estimated time of re-opening. No detour
- Highway 99 – closed both directions
 - Mudslide – Pemberton to Lillooet. Assessment in progress and no estimated time of re-opening. No detour.

Ocean Freight update

- Export embargoes placed on ALL export bookings via Vancouver
- No empties accepted to Port of Vancouver
- Port of Vancouver – vessel delays, increased yard congestion and heightened anchorage demand
- GCT Deltaport
 - Majority of vessel operations have been idled until further notice
 - No local export receiving as of Nov 19th and until further notice
 - Import CY gate remains open
- General consensus among carriers is that regular flow in and out of Vancouver will be impacted for the next few weeks at a minimum

Air Freight update

- Westjet has placed an embargo on all new booking in and out of YVR due to their warehouse being at full capacity
- Air Canada warehouse full for next 3 days
- No mention of embargoes yet, just excessive demand and lack of warehousing
